Old Business: Budget for 2024 is complete and dues will continue to be at \$250 per month. 4th floor paint, carpet, & number signs have been completed.

New Business: Ribbons on the trees are designed to be trimmed or cut. Shannon Concrete Company is keeping up with plowing. The stairwells are being painted. The callboxes are being reviewed to be updated. Brent confirmed that we were very close to our budget last year. 8 properties were sold in 2023. Condos are selling for an average of \$65,000. We are replacing some of the lighting lumes and reviewing our entrances for a fresh look. Anyone interested to run for the board in May, must be current on your dues, contact Brent.
